Please have your say on any future housing needs in the parish of Coddenham

We included several housing related questions in the parish survey which was conducted in spring 2022. However, as this is now over two years ago and was undertaken at a time when we were exiting covid-19 restrictions, the results need updating.

As with the original survey, the results will be reflected in the community plan at its next iteration. As the Coddenham community plan 2023-30 meets the criteria to become a Neighbourhood Priority Statement under the Levelling-up and Regeneration Act 2023 (LURA), it is intended to take that form in due course. Therefore, it is fundamental that it should reflect the collective views of residents to the fullest extent possible.

Moreover, to enable communities to have greater influence in shaping their place and provision of the right infrastructure, housing and amenities for their people, we are encouraged by Mid Suffolk District Council to undertake a survey to assess any current and possible future needs for housing for our parish.

Given the focus of the new government on planning reform and increased house building in the country as a whole, it is important that the views of local residents are not lost and the views of communities are taken into account.

We are keen to hear from all households. Only one person needs to complete the survey on behalf of each household. However, we would encourage you to represent your whole household, where possible.

Survey closure date is Friday, 18 October 2024. Surveys will be collected at a pre-arranged date when delivered, or maybe left in the box at the Coddenham Community Shop.

The results of the survey and the conclusions we draw from it will be shared with residents, prior to being reflected in the revised Coddenham community plan.
