POLICY DOCUMENT – SIGNAGE ON COUNCIL OWNED LAND

Overview

The Council has had to request the removal of signage on Three Cocked Hat in particular on several occasions and has now been approached by a local business requesting to instal direction signage on a permanent basis.

Decision

At the Parish Council meeting on 2 September 2024, the Council unanimously agreed to exclude all signage from commercial enterprises, whether temporary or permanent from being installed on Council owned land, unless otherwise agreed by the Parish Council.

Requests for signage for charitable or voluntary entities will be allowed with the proviso that no signage shall be erected prior to 10 days before the event date and all signage will be removed, and the site made good, immediately after the event. The signage for Coddenham Community Shop is specifically exempted from this policy.
